Important Race Day Information:

- Amateur Registration closes at 9:45 AM (10:45 AM on Friday)
- Since all amateur registration is now done electronically it will require payment to be made using either a debit or credit card
- Any class changes must be made by 11 am (no exceptions)
- You must check the heat order posted by registration area at noon to make sure you entered yourself in the correct classes with the correct bike number
- You must check results immediately after your heat race ends
- LCQ races are noted on heat results & begin as soon as heats end
- Classes with less than 8 racers are subject to run main race @ 4:30 pm
- The Main Race schedule is subject to change, please check office @ 6 PM
- The 50 & 65 classes will run approx. 3 laps during their main races. Because of this we will provide these classes with 1 extra lap during both their practice and their heat.
- We provide trophies to amateurs who place 1st to 5th
- Please pick up your trophy approximately 15 minutes after main race
- We will not mail your trophy to you, you must pick it up at the event

Important Series Information:

- **AMATEURS:** You must attend one of the first 11 Rounds and finish in the Top 12 of your class to qualify for the AMA National Championship Round in Amarillo. You may only attend the Amarillo round by qualifying at a previous round.
- You must finish the race (complete all laps) in the top 12 to qualify. If your class has less than 12 riders and you DNF (do not finish) you will NOT qualify.
- **PROS:** All 12 Rounds will count towards the overall AMA National Championship. The 250 Pro & 450 Pro Sport Class Finishes will be combined to determine the Top Pro Finishers overall.

Important Information for Pros:

- Pro Racers Will Need Transponders at ALL Events
- If you are planning to follow the Kicker Pro National Series, you will need a transponder to race. We will have a very limited number of transponders available to rent per race for \$15 per day (and a \$100 refundable deposit).
- Pros will need to provide Photo Identification to collect their earnings at the end of each event
